### Labor Approach to Human Trafficking Analyzed through Theories of Masculinities



Sociologist Yahel Kurlander (Research Fellow at TraffLab (ERC)) will present her paper '*Permanent Workers in the Backyard: Employing Thai Agricultural Labor Migrants in the Israeli Countryside*,\*' which focuses on the relationships between male farmers and their male Thai migrant workers in the past three decades. She will discuss how the Thai migrants became visible but easy to ignore; a process amplified by the tensions between farmers' hegemonic masculinity and migrant workers' marginalized masculinity.
