Originally from a supply chain management background, I have been working on modern slavery and labour exploitation in supply chains since 2015 and have co-authored the first publication on modern slavery in an academic supply chain management journal.

My work has attracted funding of more than £2.5 million, including more than £1 million as principal investigator, from a diverse range of funders. I have built the Business and Economies Programme within the University of Nottingham's Rights Lab, the world's leading research centre on modern slavery, which produces impactful, solution-oriented research in close collaboration with policymakers, business practitioners, and NGOs.
